If the presenter provides a second name, make sure to add a space between the first and the initial average. If there are additional presenters, add a comma after medium initials and proceed to add the other presenters using the same format as described. Add additional presenters in the exact order that are listed in the conference session. Do not change the order of the presenters. Before the last presenter, add an ampersand (&). <Date (s) of the conference: (2015, June 14-17). The next point, add the date of the conference. In brackets, add the year, followed by a comma and a month, followed by the day. If the conference has taken place for more days, listing the complete interval of the conference with a dash between days. Add a period after the parentheses. <Title of the conference session: the EBB and the flow of engineering leadership guidelines [Six conferences]. Next, add the title and subtitle of the conference session. The title and subtitle are separated by a colon. Capitalize only the first word of the title and subtitle and proper names. The title in italics. After the title, in brackets, add a description of the contribution (I.E., conference session, presentation poster, Keynote address, etc.). Make sure you use the description that the conference uses. Add a period after the parentheses. Source information: <Year, <City, <Country, <Conference name, <Date, <Page numbers. Complete the reference with the position of the conference and the DOI or the URL. Add the complete title of the conference followed by a comma. So, add the city, the abbreviation of state and the country where the conference took place. Finally, add the DOI in the form of or add the URL conference paper. The publication manual of the American Psychological Association (APA Style) is designed to assist writers in the preparation of research Cards (such as newspaper articles) and therefore do not actually contain any guidelines on preparing PowerPoint presentations based on the APA style. Typically, if you are required to create a presentation according to the APA style, you should clarify with your professor if you actually expect only that you can put your quotes and text references in APA style. You can quote references within the text of your presentation slide using the same APA format for in-text quotes (author, date) as in a written essay. Remember to quote sources for direct quotes, paraphrased materials and facts sources (such as market share data in the example slide). Your reference list must include the sources mentioned on your presentation slides. 7.2: Using images on slides If you use pictures, such as photographs or cliparts, on slides, you must also credit the image source. Do not reproduce images without permission. There are sources for cliparts and "public use" images according to Commons creative licenses, such as: photos are treated as APA-style figures. Therefore, the quote for the image source is included as a footnote in the caption of the figure under the photograph which includes the figure number and a description. The source of the image obtained is attributed using the following model: Figure 1. Blah Blah. From the title of the image, by author, year. Retrieved by the URL. Figure 1. Providing credit for the image Suppose that the image is copyrighted and therefore should be given credit for the image. If the image is free from copyright and royalty, you should still indicate the creator of the image and where it has been recovered, for example image created by Josie Lee; Recovered by URL. If you are using a creative Commons license image, make sure you attribute the image correctly according to the specific license; Consult the best practices for the allocation of the interior of the Wiki DC for information. You can be able to give such a credit in the slide notes, but if your instructor expects a tight adherence to the APA style rules, the credit should appear in the note. Copyright considerations When you provide a credit for the image, try to determine who the copyright of the image belongs to, instead of simply citing the website where you found it. Just because alt is on the website or blog of someone does not mean that you can use the image without copyright. If the PowerPoint presentation is going to be presented only to your instructor and cohort, you don't need to get the copyright permission to use images as your use is part of Fair Dealing policy. If, however, the Image will be used in any work that will be published outside the university (for example, thesis or posting the presentation of PowerPoint on your personal blog), you must contact the copyright holder to request permission to use images.
