Connect the Sonos Roam to your Wi-Fi network using the included USB cable and the Bluetooth pairing instructions below. 2. Download the Sonos app from the App Store or Google Play. [**Bluetooth Pairing Instructions**](#) 1. Turn on your device's Bluetooth setting. 2. Press and hold the power button on the Sonos Roam for about 2 seconds until you hear the pairing tone (the second one), then release. 3. Choose the Sonos Roam from the list of available devices in your Bluetooth settings. [**Using Voice Control**](#) 1. Locate the microphone light to turn it on or off. 2. When the microphone is on, auto Trueplay tuning is enabled and voice control is active. 3. If you need to verify your user ID or change passwords, tap Account in the app. You can also restrict access to explicit music by opening System > Parental Controls in the app. Sign into your Sonos account to set filter options. Note that you can limit max volume for each room using Set max volume feature. To connect your TV without an HDMI ARC port, use the included optical audio adapter. Remove its protective cap and attach it to the HDMI cable. Connect the adapter to your TV's digital audio out port. Make sure to download the free Sonos app from the app store to set up and control your system. You'll need it for voice control and other features. Touch your Sonos Arc to turn on or off the microphone. When the light is on, voice control is active; when it's off, it's inactive. If you've installed a voice service but turned off the microphone, you can still use voice commands by pressing and holding . Release the button to turn off voice control again. Use the HDMI cable to connect your soundbar to your TV. If your TV lacks an ARC port, use the optical adapter as well. Insert the HDMI cable fully into Arc's HDMI port and connect it to your TV's ARC or eARC port. 1. The Sonos Arc can be connected to a TV via ARC, eARC, or ARC/eARC ports, while using an HDMI port may result in no sound output. 2.
