Observe the outflow; the water will initially be cloudy gradually clearing as the filter cleans. Once the water runs clear switch the valve to rinse for a short period to remove any remaining debris from the filter bed. Then return the valve to the filter position to resume normal operation. For more thorough cleaning consider periodically replacing the sand. Consult your models specifications for sand type and quantity. Regularly inspect the filter tank and connections for leaks or damage. Repair or replace any faulty components promptly. Additionally maintain proper water chemistry as balanced water chemistry reduces the buildup of contaminants in the filter.
