Dumplings are significant because they resemble ancient Chinese money coins, believed to accumulate riches in the coming year.Longevity Noodles symbolize longevity and people who eat them without cutting may live a long life ahead of them. The dish is also found at birthdays, weddings, and ceremonies for new babies.Steamed Chicken is an important fixture on dining tables during significant events because it's often served whole, including head and feet, symbolizing a whole family.The Chinese phrase Nian Nian You Yu means year year got surplus/excess, which is why steamed fish is a traditional dish. Spring Rolls are cylindrical rolls filled with meat, vegetables, or sweet ingredients and turn golden-yellow when fried, resembling gold bars.Tangyuan is a glutinous rice ball in sweet syrup soup associated with the Lantern Festival and Winter Solstice Festival but also found on reunion dinner tables due to its round shape symbolizing reunion. Fun fact: Tangyuan can be made with various sweet fillings like red bean paste or chocolate paste. Shrimps are believed to bring happiness, liveness, and good fortune during Chinese New Year.Prosperty Cake is a steamed cupcake-like pastry split at the top, symbolizing prosperity and fortune.
