No one seems to agree on cover letters. How long do you need to perfect them? Do recruit managers read them? Is it better to send your resume and finish it? I am not part of Human Resources, but I was approached by candidates who wondered if their presentation letter would be read. My answer is one that not many of them wanted to hear: "sometimes." Sometimes she'll be read. Other times, you can get away with just sending it to your resume -- as when I network your sense in the application for a location. The truth is that you can not make a case-by-case forecast -- and better prevent than cure. For most, having a cover letter will give you an advantage in the senses your resume does not. It allows you to show off your writing skills, provide details you could not measure on your resume, demonstrate your passion and show your will put in as much time and effort as possible. Basic The example above is a basic (but great) cover letter. The numbered sections are explained in more detail below. 1. Header The level of formality that the header has will depend on the company to which it applies. If you are applying to a formal activity, it is important to use a formal header to open the cover letter, as in the sample above. Enter your address, date and company address. But if you are applying to a company that is not so formal, you do not need to include your and the company's addresses. You can still include the date. 2. Using "Who can worry" is ok, but you may want to take the time to search the recruiter's name or hiring online managers. If you're doing your research and you're not sure you've found the right name, then you should definitely use the Generic - But if you are sure, then it shows you to put in the effort to find their name and take the eye of the recruiter. If you have the name of the recruiter, greets them with their full name, or with their title of courtesy (ie Mr., Mrs., or Mrs.)? Like the header, it depends on the company's formality level. This is not the place to enter the details of why you are a great candidate - this is for the second paragraph. Here, simply list some key reasons in a sentence to set the rest of your letter. Template 13: Freelance cover letter Taking it here. If you are looking for freelance work, your bigger goal is to get your strengths quickly, so busy customers will not pass from your presentation letter. In addition, if you are sending multiple cover letters to different customers, we recommend that you direct each to the unique customer goals. For example, if a customer is looking for SEO-optimized content related to marketing, we recommend that you highlight the past experience with marketing content; This will change if, for example, the customer is looking for fitness content. Forreason, it is a good idea to structure your presentation letter so as to start with a) credentials or past references, and b) bullet-point information related to the customer's goal, as shown in the presentation letter above. A Model 14: Editor's cover letter Download it here. If you're applying for a director's seat, we suggest you start by explaining how you successfully managed a similar role in the past, or why you think you're qualified and ready to face new responsibilities for the first time. In the above presentation letter, the candidate does a good job describing how he had success in a leadership role earlier: "In the last five years, I have successfully developed and maintained all data systems, including times and recordings for a company with more than 100 employees. » You will have to demonstrate how your skills align with a position of Director, both through organization and leadership, and when possible, where you have received awards for your hard work (e.g. "I have earned a prize for the most valuable administrative staff member". A Writing a presentation letter is easier to say than to do. Do not hesitate to spend a lot of time writing it and editing it. Or, ask a friend or family member to read it over and give you feedback.
