Jujutsu kaisen episode 1 review

Itadori Yuji/Episode 1 Jujutsu Kaisen is a captivating anime that has garnered immense popularity among fans of dark-themed shows. Having devoured the manga and thoroughly enjoyed its anime adaptation, I decided to embark on an in-depth review of every episode available, starting with this first installment. ****Episode 1: Ryomen Sukuna**** The episode commences with Itadori Yuji's poignant conversation with his terminally ill grandfather, showcasing Yuji's compassionate nature. He subsequently visits school, where he participates in a ritual with his friends from the Occult Club, using an Ouija board. However, their activities are interrupted by a student council member who disbands the club due to its lack of real activities. The Occult Club leader presents a compelling argument about a cursed spirit causing mysterious illnesses among rugby players, but her claims are dismissed as mere speculation. Meanwhile, Megumi Fushiguro, a young Jujutsu sorcerer, arrives on campus and detects a cursed spirit in the rugby field. Yuji's exceptional skills are subsequently recognized by the sports team coach, who challenges him to a shot put competition to prove his worth. Yuji accepts the challenge and effortlessly defeats the coach, earning his place in the club. Unbeknownst to Yuji and his friends, the box they've obtained contains Sukuna's Finger, a special-grade cursed object. The episode concludes with Yuji visiting his grandfather in the hospital, unaware of the events that have transpired. **##** Yuji's grandfather passes away, leaving him feeling alone. However, he finds strength to continue from his grandfather's words of wisdom, telling his friends that he must help people whenever possible and be surrounded by others at his time of death. When Megumi arrives, Yuji informs him about the cursed object that is causing harm, and together they head to the school to stop it. At the school, they encounter a massive amount of cursed energy as Sukuna's finger is opened, releasing the Curse Of Spirits into the world. Looking forward to seeing everyone at the meeting tomorrow and discussing our strategies, Megumi finishes the conversation by saying there's a very slim chance this will go horribly wrong - it's like finding a needle in a haystack - for the curse to be reborn in someone new. Sukuna is less than thrilled with Jujutsu sorcerers and lets Megumi know his death will be slow and painful, before Megumi takes a stand by forming two fists at a 90-degree angle which hints at something big happening soon. However, just as Megumi is about to continue, his sensei Saturo Gojo bursts in and gives Sukuna the beating of his life, thanks to Yuji's hidden control over the cursed spirit. Gojo surprisingly wants to switch bodies with Sukuna but Yuji says he's not sure if that can happen - after all, Gojo is way too strong for him. The two have a fierce battle which Gojo wins hands down, and he asks Megumi to report back to Jujutsu High School so they can figure out what makes this kid tick and help him control his cursed spirit better. The first episode of Jujutsu Kaisen sets a somber tone, as Itadori's passing away is portrayed in a straightforward and sincere manner. This is juxtaposed with Fushiguro's exposition on curses, which feels somewhat rushed but still engaging. The introduction of the cursed objects and Talismans adds depth to the story. Despite some reservations about the animation production, the combat scenes showcase improved fluidity and dynamics. Itadori's character development is notable, as his fun personality contrasts with a more serious aspect revealed in this episode. His thoughts on "a correct death" are intriguing and seem to be an ongoing theme. The pacing could be faster, but the balance of humor and horror is welcome. The world building and mystery elements are present, although they could benefit from further exploration. Overall, while the first episode doesn't immediately hook viewers, it establishes a foundation for future growth. Looking forward to diving into Mappa's Jujutsu Kaisen anime, where I'll be reviewing each episode individually. Please note that this review contains massive spoilers for those who haven't watched the series yet. Episode 1: Ryomen Sukuna The first episode kicks off with a phone call between main character Itadori Yuji and his terminally ill grandfather. We see a glimpse of Yuji's kind heart and bold personality, as well as his close relationship with his grandfather. After hanging up, Yuji heads to school, where he meets up with his friends from the Occult Club. The club is about to disband due to lack of activities and members, but they convince the student council that their rituals are worth continuing. Meanwhile, a mysterious young Jujutsu sorcerer named Megumi Fushiguro senses a cursed energy on campus and investigates. Yuji's skills in school lead him to be signed up for the sports team, where he faces off against the coach in a shot put competition. Yuji's impressive performance earns him a spot in the team, but what his friends don't know is that he's actually holding onto a mysterious box containing Sukuna's Finger. The leader of the Occult Club gives the box to Yuji, and although he initially agrees to keep it, he decides to stay in the club and pursue the truth behind the mysterious object. As Yuji visits his grandfather at the hospital, Megumi senses an enormous amount of cursed energy surrounding him. Yuji's grandfather dies after telling him some final words of wisdom. He urges Yuji to stay strong, help others whenever he can, and not be alone at the time of his own death. Yuji is taken aback by this, but it sparks something within him when Megumi later calls for the cursed object that has been passed down in their family. Despite being in mourning, Yuji refuses to hand over the object, saying his leader already has possession of it. Megumi warns Yuji about the dangers of the cursed item and threatens that Yuji's friends will die if he doesn't take care of it. This prompts Yuji to remember his grandfather's words and join Megumi in going after the cursed object at school. Upon arrival, they find that some sort of curse has been unleashed within the building, causing chaos and destruction. The occult Club leader tries to open an ancient seal around Sukuna's finger, releasing a massive amount of energy that causes smaller curses to spawn and attack them. Megumi summons his demon dogs to fight off these curses, but they get cornered on the 4th floor. Just as all hope seems lost for Megumi and the club members, Yuji bursts through the window and punches one of the curses, saving his friends from being eaten alive. Megumi takes advantage of this distraction to kill the curse and then asks Yuji to hand over Sukuna's finger. However, another cursed spirit intervenes just as they're about to complete the transfer. The cursed spirit attacks both Yuji and Megumi, causing them to split apart in an attempt to save each other. Megumi gets smashed through a wall, leaving him vulnerable, but Yuji insists on fighting off the curse instead of fleeing. As Megumi yells at Yuji to escape, Yuji refuses, determined that his friend deserves a proper death. In a desperate bid to save Megumi, Yuji tries to fight off the curse and loses grip on Sukuna's finger in the process. However, he then catches the finger with his mouth and swallows it whole, unleashing an immense amount of cursed energy within him. This transformation turns Yuji into the Curse Of Spirits himself, Sukuna. With this newfound power, Sukuna easily dispatches the remaining curses and exclaims how happy he is to be alive once again. The first episode of Jujutsu Kaisen sets the stage for Yuji's journey by showcasing his strong will to fight against Sukuna, a powerful cursed spirit. Sukuna's ominous presence is deftly countered by Megumi, who then faces off against Gojo, known as "The Strongest Sorcerer." This confrontation highlights Gojo's unmatched strength and agility, leaving Sukuna no match for him. The episode effectively establishes Yuji's character traits, including his bravery and athletic prowess, making his future battles more compelling. Additionally, the display of Gojo's abilities serves as a testament to his reputation as the strongest sorcerer, raising questions about how he would fare in a serious fight versus when his emotions are in check.
