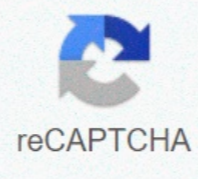

Back to sport Back to the track and the track and field meetings are races between two or more teams in which highly qualified and trained athletes challenge each other in the race, in the jump and launch of challenges to determine which team will be declared a winner. It goes from small races between two middle school club teams to professional races among the best athletes in the country. Most track and field meetings follow a similar structure in all locations and at all levels of skills. Before the start of the meeting between the track and field almost all athletes arrive well before the beginning of the meeting between the track and field to adequately prepare for the race. Athletes often have to check in, both with their coaches and with an official, before starting to prepare for the race. Then athletes can prepare themselves wearing uniform, eating, using the bathroom, or anything else that they might need to do. Officials and volunteers who will help to administer the track meeting and field must soon arrive so you can make sure that everything goes according to plans. Event on the track In order to inform the athletes of the upcoming events and their relatively scheduled times, an official will communicate notices to the whole track using something like a trombone or a stadium sound system. A 400-meter athlete should listen to an official who announces something of the type À «The first 400-meter ringing» which indicates that her race will soon start. Usually an official will announce three calls to experience the athletes of event times. At the third call, athletes should be very close to the starting point of their race, if not already on the starting line. Then the athlete competes in the race. While officials record the results of a short distance race, athletes must remain in their lanes, but while the officials record the results of a medium or long distance race, athletes must form an off-track row from the first place at the first place [™] last place. Field Events Field Events are managed slightly differently than track events. Field events have their standard order, even if an official will announce their times relatively programmed to the whole track. Athletes have three attempts for almost all field events. The best attempt at each athlete is recorded as a final score. However, field events like the top jump and pole time have a starting height. Each athlete has three attempts to overcome this height otherwise are eliminated. After all athletes have gone, the height is increased slightly and the athletes try to overcome it three times. is repeated until only one athlete remains and the winner is declared.
