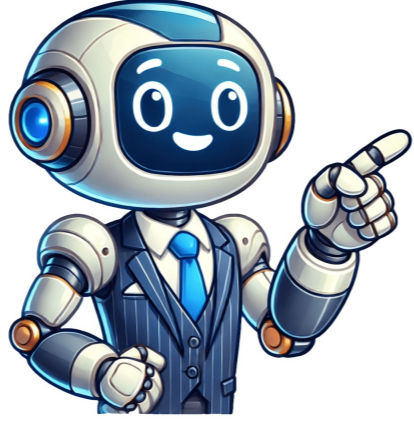

A predicate is the part of a sentence that contains the verb and tells us what action the subject performed.
