## Lion and gorilla fight to the death

[3] Fearing for the boy’s life, a zoo worker shot and killed Harambe. The incident was recorded on video and received extensive international coverage and commentary, including controversy over the choice to use lethal force. A number of primatologists and conservatves later wrote that the zoo had no choice under the circumstances, and that it highlighted the danger of zoo animals close to humans and the need for better standards of care. [4] He coined the name after listening to the song “Harambe (Working Together for Freedom)” by Rita Marley, Bob Marley’s widow. [5] Harambee is a Swahili term for common work. [5] On September 18, 2014, Harambe was transferred to the Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Garden to learn adult gorilla behavior and join a new social group. [6][7] Incident On May 28, 2016, a three-year-old boy visiting the Cincinnati Zoo fell into the ditch at Gorilla World habitat. [8][9] Witnesses said they heard the boy say he wanted to enter the gorilla enclosure. [10] The boy then climbed a 3-foot (0.91 m) fence, crawled through 4 feet (1.2 m) of bushes, and then fell 15 feet (4.6 m) into a shallow moat. Zoo officials immediately signaled the three gorillas in the habitat to go back inside, and two females did. However, the third gorilla, the inquisitive 440-pound (200 kg) silverback male, Harambe, climbed down into the pitinvestigate the child sketches in the water. [9] In the next 10 minutes, Harambe has become increasingly “hang and disoriented” by the audience’s screams. [11] [12] He brought the child through the water, occasionally proposing it when he sat, or pushing him down when he rose. [11] Harambe showed the behavior “strisciante”, walking with legs and arms rigidly extended to appear larger - a bluff move, although one with intrinsic danger should throw or drag the boy around too roughly. 12 Then Harambe brought the boy to a staircase from the ditch on the mainland. Fear for the welfare of the boy, zoo officials made the decision to kill the gorilla, doing so with a single shotgun. The Cincinnati Firefighters said the boy was in Harambe’s legs when the shot was fired. [9] Harambe was killed one day after his 17th birthday. [11] The boy was given an evaluation of trauma and transported to the Medical Center for Children of Cincinnati; Her wounds were not at risk of life. [1] Reactions Memorial for Harambe at the Cincinnati Zoo, on June 12, 2016 This incident was recorded in a dramatic video by an anonymous viewer and uploaded to YouTube, where it became viral, sparkly global advertising and controversy. [13] [14] Some observers said that it was unclear if Harambe would likely damage the child. [15] [16] Others called the boy’s parents or the zoo to be held responsible for the death of Gorilla. [17] Director Thane Maynard said: “The baby was dragged around... the head was banging on the concrete. This wasn’t a delicate thing. The child was at risk.” [19] [20] The police investigated possible criminal charges against parents, while the parents defended the zoo’s actions. [21] [22] The boy’s mother has also become the target of harassment on the Internet and social media. [23] On June 6, 2016, the Ohio I Deters Prosecutor Joe said that his mother would not face any charges of unlawfulness. [24] The zoo was studied by the association of zoos and aquariums (AZA), which establishes standards for zoos and USDA. [25] Several vigilants took place to honor the death of Harambe. A candlelight Vigil was held in Hyde Park, London. [26] Anthony Seta, an animal rights activist, spoke in a wake at the Cincinnati zoo, saying: “I’m not here to decide what was right and what was wrong, the fact is that a gorilla who just celebrated his birthday was killed.” [27] The film received criticism from several high-profile celebrities, including Ricky Gervais, Brian May, and Piers Morgan. [28] The incident triggered the debate between biologists and primatologists about the fact that Gorillas and other primates should be kept in captivity. [12] Jane Goodall said that according to the video it seemed that Harambe was trying to protect the child. [29] Goodall then delivered a longest explanation in an interview with the President of the International Fund for Animal Wellness, concluding that the Zoo had no choice but to kill Harambe. [30] You wrote, “was terrible for the child, parents, parents, the zoo, the caretakers and the public. But when people come into contact with wild animals, life and death decisions sometimes have to be made. [25] Goodall said that as long as humans and wild animals are kept close by in zoos, there is no way to prevent accidents from happening, but he believed that zoos “with the highest standards of care” could play an important role. [25] Zookeeper Jack Hanna strongly defended the zoo’s actions as the “right decision”, noting that a soothing dart could take effect five to ten minutes and could aggravate Harambe further. [31] Primatologist Frans de Waal said he saw few options for the zoo: “A gorilla is so immensely strong that even with the best intentions - and we’re not sure if Harambe had any - the child’s death was a likely result. “ [32] Internet memes After the killing, Harambe became the subject of more viral memes. [33] Vox wrote in November that Harambe has an “indissoluble status as the 2016 meme of the year” [34] People magazine wrote that “Harambe continues to live in the collective mind of the internet, entering a rare and revered state of meme status.” [35] One of the most widespread meme was noted by the Washington Post and New York magazine which observed a proliferation of overly high and fake tributes to Harambe. “The idea is, the more intense and the more sincere, that sees the expression of mourning is, the more fun is the joke”.[33] An example of this was the “Dicks out for Harambe” meme (“dicks” like slang for guns) which called in front for armed revenge for Harambe’s death.[7] 37[38][39] Aja Romano of Vox wrote that “If I were a progressive, Harambe’s meme gave you the opportunity to mock what you saw as hypocritical haranguing of mainstream social justice, avoiding a real probability A meme is a game about conspiracy theories, like “Bush did Har Harambe both”, a reference to the 9/11 conspiracy theories. [41] In Australia, people joked about supporting Harambe’s corpse as a writing candidate on the ballot in the federal election. [42] Polling’s public policy included Harambe in their mandate for the U.S. presidential election. Harambe had 5% support at the end of July 2016 (as opposed to Green Party candidate Jill Stein) and 2% in August 2016 (linked with Stein).[43] Thane Maynard reacted negatively: “We are not amused by Harambe’s memes, petitions and signs. Our zoological family is still healing, and the constant mention of Harambe makes it harder for us to move on. We are honoring Harambe by ridiculing our gorilla conservation efforts and encouraging others to join us”.[45] At the end of August, the zoo deleted its Twitter account after being targeted every day by trolls who were Harambe. [46] The zoo resumed his account after two months. [59] On June 16, 2017, the Satiriche The Onion news site published an article on the professional Wrestler Big Show killed by WWE after a seven-year-old child entered a steel cage during a live event in Indianapolis. [60] On October 18, 2021, a 7-meter high bronze statue of Harambe was illegally placed in the Bowling Green Park, opposite the Taurus Charger statue. The event was carried out by the organizers who promote sapien.network, a social network being developed to put the human needs first. Subsequent developments in September 2017, the zoo added MSHindi, a 29-year-old western plain gorilla, transferred from the Louisville zoo.
