Figure out what category best describes the item(s) you are selling and go there.Post your Classified Ad: Once in the proper sub-forum you can click the "New Thread" button just as if you were posting anywhere else on the forum. Once clicked you will be presented with the standard new thread form with one special feature, the "Prefix" field which contains 6 choices: [Want to Sell], [Want to Buy], [Want to Trade], [Want to Sell/Trade], [Want to Buy/Trade] and [CLOSED]. When posting a new classified pick one of the first 5 that fits what you are trying to do, the the 6th one is for later.Wait for responses: People will either email you or private message you with questions, comments, and offers. Doing so will result in an immediate ban from the discussion forum completely, most likely forever.Suggestions and Tips for Classified AdsThe more information the better: Posting an ad with the title "[Want To Sell] Handgun" is probably going to be ignored by everyone. Be specific, try: "[Want To Sell] Glock 19, slightly used, \$475 in Philadelphia". The latter will stand out far better because people know what you're selling, what you want, and how easy or difficult it will be to get it.Include pictures if you have them: People love to see pictures, it gives them a sense of security to know what they're getting. I understand that there are no laws prohibiting this in PA except that the buyer be a legal purchaser of a firearm. The sticky in the classified section says: Pertinent Pennsylvania Law: 1. Face To Face transfers/sales of longarms (shotgun or rifle) are legal in Pennsylvania. There is no requirement to use a FFL for a transfer of a longarm in PA, as long as neither person is a "prohibited person" (legally unable to purchase a firearm) and both are legal aged(18 or older) residents of Pennsylvania. It's SUGGESTED that you provide a Bill of Sale and check ID on purchasers. My question is how do you "check" the ID. If I ask for a copy of the buyers drivers license this will do nothing for me as far as knowing if he/she is legal besides verifying that they are indeed a PA resident. Asking to see a LTCF could give some assurance that the buyer isn't prohibited - or at least wasn't when it was issued.For the record, I would not participate in a transaction where I was required to show my LTCF to the seller, but as the seller, you should take whatever steps necessary to satisfy your concerns.
