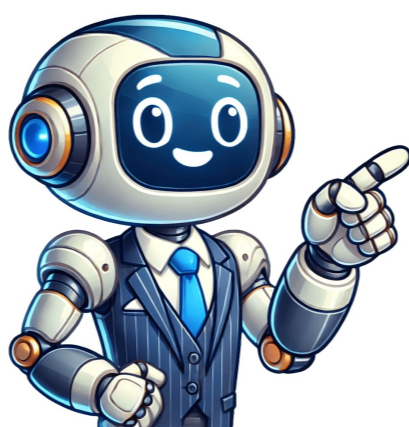

to complete the main story quests at least once on your main/alt character, you don't have to do them again and can fast-track by grinding instead. Take the "Simplified Questline" to complete all of the requirements for the season pass, or you can follow the main questline if that's what you prefer. If you take the Simplified questline, then you need to level yourself, either by following this guide or asking a friend to power level you. There are two different types of EXP buffs: Combat EXP This increases your Level EXP gained when killing monsters. It doesn't affect the EXP you gain from questing. Skill EXP This increases your Skill EXP gained when killing monsters. When your "Skill Level" gets to 100%, you will gain Skill points to allocate to your class skills. Although most spots are designed for solo grinding, there are a few places that support groups of 2, 3, or 5 players, and will drop separate loot for each player. When monsters are killed in a party, the combat EXP from the monster is shared between all party members. However, the EXP you gain isn't just equally split depending on the number of people in the party. The share is actually higher, to incentivize leveling in a group. For example: With 2 people in the party, a monster that gives 100 EXP, would give 60 EXP to party member 1, and 60 EXP to party member 2. With 3 people in the party, a monster that gives 100 EXP, would give 50 EXP to party member 1, 50 EXP to party member 2, and 50 EXP to party member 3. There is also no difference in your EXP gain when you have 3 party members, compared to having 5 party members. This makes 3 person grind spots, like Mirumok, a great place to power-level others. You can AFK level at the Training Dummies using a Book of Training if you are level 50 or higher. AFK leveling can boost your Skill and Combat EXP. The Book of Training costs 1 million silver per hour and the amount of EXP you get is reduced compared to grinding. You can use EXP buffs to increase the amount of EXP you get when AFK leveling. For more information check our AFK Leveling guide. Power leveling is when a high-level player kills monsters while you are in a party and standing nearby. You will get EXP from the monsters killed and can level very quickly. Powerleveling can take as little as 2 hours to get to level 56 if the person helping you has high AP and you use all available EXP buffs. However, I only recommend power leveling if it is an alt character and NOT your first or main character. This is because power leveling leaves you with very few skill points (approx 400 - 500) and you will not be able to get all the skills you need to grind on your own. As well, if it is your first character, then it's recommended to create a season character so that you can get a good start with gear. Season characters require you to do the main story quest, so you will have to do it eventually anyway. If your friends are willing to help you all the way then you should be fine, but please understand that power leveling to the level you want to be will not stop you from having to grind more for money/skill points. It's also important to note that if there is a 10-level difference between the highest level character and the lowest, then all party members will not get loot. One of the benefits of tagged characters is that any Combat and Skill EXP gained through killing monsters is shared with both characters. For example, if you grind on Character A, the same amount of EXP will be gained on Character B. You can also level with Character B and gain shared EXP on Character A. \*AFK Leveling via Training Dummies or Combat EXP gained through life skills is not shared. After gaining EXP on one of your tagged characters, you must collect the EXP by logging onto the other character and pressing the "Get EXP" button in the Tag window. When obtaining accumulated EXP, leveling up is temporarily halted at Lv. 49, 56, and 60. You will need to press the "Get EXP" again to level up with the accumulated EXP to the next threshold. You will also need to complete the "[To Level 50] Go Beyond Your Own Limits" quest through the Black Spirit (/) in order to level from Lv. 49 to Lv. 50. Black Desert does not have a level cap, but the "soft cap" for levels is considered to be 62. Once you have reached level 62, there are very minor buffs for reaching higher levels and it is not essential or required to grind purely for EXP. After reaching level 61/62, you can focus on grinding for other goals to improve your gear or collect treasure items. The highest current level reached by a player is level 66. You can choose between Ancient Stone Chamber and Mountain of Eternal Winter. I would personally recommend choosing the Ancient Stone Chamber for the smoothest leveling experience. You can still complete the Mountain of Eternal Winter questline at a later date on your character. When you load into the game on a new character, you will also have to complete a short tutorial. This takes approximately 10 minutes and unfortunately, you can only skip it if you have already completed it before on another character. For the early levels, follow the main story quests. When you arrive at Vellia town, you will talk to Alustin and will have the option to follow the Main Story, or take the Simplified Questline. If you are a new player and it is your first character, please level to 56 by selecting the "[Crossroad] Main" option and following the main story quests: Balenos > Serendia > Calpheon > Mediah. You can use our Beginner/Returning Guide for more information about leveling your first character. Take the Simplified Questline option if this is an alt character and you would like to level via grinding. Requirements for the Simplified Questline: Completed the "[Pet] Bared's Junaid" quest from Bared in Mediah This pet quest can be found in your Suggested quest tab under "[ADV Support] Pets, Loyal Companions". After taking the Simplified questline, go to Fughar to take the next quests up to "[Season] Following in His Footsteps". Now you can grind to reach higher levels and follow our recommended leveling spots. After reaching certain levels, you can talk to your Black Spirit to obtain all the rewards you would normally get by completing the main story quests. Kill the monsters outside of Vellia to level up to 15. Next, we will move to Morett Plantation just outside of Heidel. You want to kill the monsters here until you are level 21. For levels 21 to 25, kill the monsters at Glish Swamp. Next, move over to Bloody Monastery, located south of Glish, for level 25 to 30. Move to Red Orc Camp (west of Heidel/Glish) for level 30 to 35. You can kill monsters at Keplan Mine (north of Keplan) for level 35 - 40. Next, move to Saunils Camp (southwest of Keplan) for levels 40 to 45. For levels 45 to 48, kill the monsters in Mansha Forest (west of Calpheon) For levels 48 to 52, you can kill the Catfishmen at Lake Kaia. When you reach level 49, a popup will appear at the top of your screen saying "To complete the [To Level 50]! Go Beyond Your Own Limits quest and level up, you must summon the Black Spirit (/)." Summon your Black Spirit and take the quest "[To Level 50]! Go Beyond Your Own Limits" Then use the Chat option at your Black Spirit to complete the quest You cannot level past 49 if you don't complete this quest. For levels 52 to 56 you have a few options to grind at, the location depends on your current gear. At level 56, you also want to go and complete your class Succession and Awakening quests to fully unlock your skill tree. These quests are obtainable from your Black Spirit, and can be found in your quest log (O) under Suggestions. You can still grind monsters if that is what you prefer, but questing can be quicker and does not require monster killing, so you don't need gear to get a high level. Leveling via questing is also the fastest way to reach 60 - 61, taking approximately 1 hour. In order to level via questing, you will need to complete a long questline to obtain the "Chenga Tome". This item can be equipped on any of your characters (including Season Charactrs) and gives increased EXP from quests - making it vital if you would like to level via questing. Use the following guides if you would like to level via questing: These are the recommended spots after you have reached level 58 or higher. There are also various other grinding locations in the game and all have different requirements, silver per hour, item drops, etc. At this point, you want to basically grind where is best for you and what you are looking to achieve. For example, you may want to start grinding for the Infinite Potions if you are a new player. We'll cover everything from early game leveling tips to endgame strategies. So whether you're a new player or just looking to speed up your progress, read on for the best ways to power through BDO! BDO doesn't like hard caps and instead opts for soft caps for many of its stats, including levels. There is no max level in BDO, but leveling becomes progressively harder, especially after level 60 and 62. The highest level character in BDO in 2022 is level 67. Just going from 66 to 67 took him almost two and a half years of grinding around the clock. Most players will stop actively trying to level up at 61 or 62, as this is considered a soft cap. As we said above, leveling to 67 will take years of non-stop grinding. But reaching around levels 55-60 can be done in just a few hours or days, depending on your play style and leveling method. If you are leveling your first character, it is wise to stick to the main story. It's fast and you will get a ton of valuable rewards like bag space, and you will also earn Contribution Points and Energy for your character and your whole Family/Account that you will need. For more tips about your first character, check out our BDO Beginners guide. As we said above, stick with questing for your first/main character. For your alts you can pick whatever you enjoy. At level 60 the fastest way to level 61 is questing with the Chenga Tome. For the purpose of leveling fast seasonal characters get a 100% XP bonus on Season servers amongst the plethora of other advantages to being a seasoned character. Ancient Stone Chamber has some amazing rewards for new characters. Mountain of Eternal Winter is faster. New characters can choose to start in the Ancient Stone Chamber or the new Mountain of Eternal Winter Zone. The Mountain is faster and is designed for new players to quickly catch up. It is recommended that you go through the Ancient Stone Chamber and the main story at least once though. Powerleveling is possible in BDO. High-level players can group up with a lower-level player and grind high-level content. The character being powerleveled will have few skill points and will need to grind those themselves. AFK leveling in BDO is possible after level 50 and is a good way of spending your AFK time. Simply head to Jamey Drucker in any major city to buy a "Book of Training - Combat". Now you can start attacking the nearby scarecrows for some free AFK XP. Jamie Drucker is the man to talk to start AFK leveling. "Chenga - Sherekhan Tome of Wisdom" can be obtained through a series of quests from the Black Spirit at level 53+. It will grant you 30% extra XP from quests. The Chenga Tome is a must have at later levels. These can be bought from Wacky Toshi who can be found all over the world. If you are grinding it is worth picking up the appropriate Marni's Stones for the spot where you are grinding for some extra XP. Marni's Stones offers a bit of extra XP when grinding. XP bonuses can add up and make leveling a lot faster. There are A LOT of XP bonuses available in BDO. Try to have as many as you can active but don't stress out about getting all of them. You will get a lot of XP, skill points, money, and some nice gear and other rewards along the way. If you are struggling with a quest feel free to ask for help in /region or use a leveling guide. Follow the main storyline through the following areas: Balenos (Vellia) > Serendia (Heidel) > Calpheon > Media > Valencia For an even faster route, choose the Mountain of Eternal Winter zone when making a new character. This will take you to level 51+ in just a matter of hours. Continue following the main quest line until you finish Valencia. Remember to do the questline for the Chenga Tome at 53+. At level 59 you can move on to grinding or for the fastest leveling you can do sidequests in the following areas: Brellin Farm > Outpost Supply Port > Calpheon Northwestern Outpost > Star's End > Ash Forest > Archer Guard Post > Polly's Forest > Grana > Manshaum Forest > Viv Foretta Hamlet > Old Wisdom Tree At level 60 the fastest way to level is still sidequests. Go to the following areas Shady Tree Forest > Kamalsyvia Vicinity > Lemoria Guard Post > Caduil Forest > Ahil Conflict Zone > Marcha Outpost > Gayak Altar > Sherekhan Necropolis > Night Crow Post > Tshira Ruins > Black Spirit Questline > Khimut Lumber Camp > Marak Farm Grinding is always a viable option in BDO, and you will spend a lot of time grinding anyway, especially at end-game.
